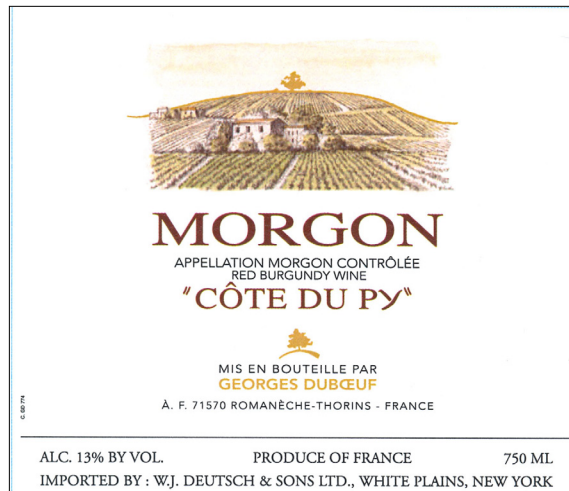

“The 2009 Morgon Cote de Py Domaine La Coque – tasted from tank – was rather stubbornly reduced even after a good shaking, but its pungent nose of bacon fat, cassis leaf, fresh red raspberry, and black tea was still bracing and provocative. The palate impression is juicy enough. Notes of carob, sage, and pencil lead add to the complexity of a persistent if slightly rough finish.
