“Representing as usual one of Duboeuf’s larger lots, the 2009 Morgon Domaine Mont Chavy (tasted from tank) continues a qualitative streak that obviously reflects high viticultural standards. With juicy vivacity yet considerable richness, this pours forth ripe, fresh blackberry and mulberry, accented with bay, mint, sage, black tea, and citrus oil, as well as notes of game. As it sloughs off a bit of reduction, an even sharper focus and stimulating edge of berry skin emerge, along with stone-licking underlying minerality in a lip-smacking finish that delivers on the complexity promised in the nose. This exceptional value should remain delightful for at least 3-4 years.”
