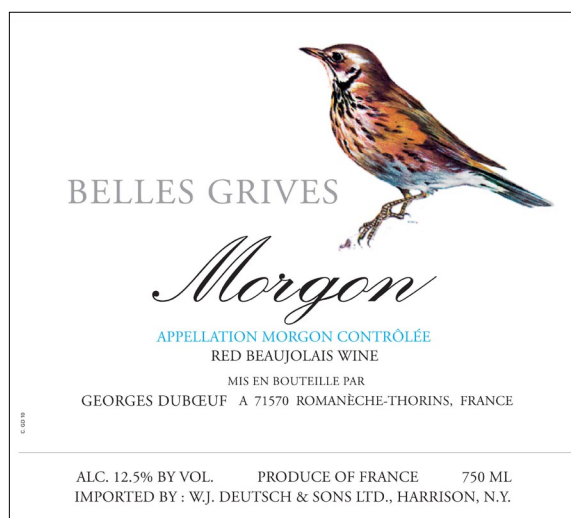

“The 2008 Morgon Belles Grives — representing another large lot — is brimming with bright red raspberry right down to the seeds, giving and invigoratingly tart, faintly bitter cask to its sappy, truly palate-staining fruit. A lovely, iris-like bitter sweet floral note wafts throughout. I’d never heard of this property, but I’d put my money on bottles of this wine being worth following for three or more years, and I certainly hope some of them will end up in the U.S.”

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
