“Representing another large lot, the 2008 Morgon Mont Chavy hails from a domaine whose proprietors Georges Duboeuf praises as “particularly meticulous,” and it’s easy to smell and taste that here. A cool, tart blackberry and cassis character dramatically contrasting with that of the Jean Descombes Morgon, and an unexpectedly stony note team up on the firm palate and in a finish of impressive grip. I would not hesitate to follow this for 2-3 years.”
