“Sparr’s 2008 Riesling Reserve smells of apricot, gooseberry, and herbs, which carry into a lusciously juicy palate along with faintly bitter accents of lemon zest and juniper berry. A pleasant salinity informs the finish, although I wish that more of the sheer juiciness were carried along as well. Plan to enjoy this over the next couple of years while it is still fresh and citric.”
