Château Bonnet lies to the north of the Entre-Deux-Mers, on the clay chalk slopes of the commune of Grézillac, overlooking the Dordogne Valley some 8 miles south of Saint Émilion. The Bonnet estate dates back to the 17th century.

NEW PACKAGING: MODERN, CLEAN, INFORMATIVE

The entire Château Bonnet range will now be updated with this new design.

NEW VINIFICATION and AGING TECHNIQUES

Made from 50% Cabernet Sauvignon and 50% Merlot. Longer maceration and higher extraction. Aging in oak barrels for 12 months (25% new French oak).

NEW TASTE PROFILE

A richer and more fruit-forward style that can be appreciated by younger consumers; attractive to consumers new to Bordeaux, but maintains its typicity which will equally please Bordeaux connoisseurs.
