COMMENTS

Light, easy to drink, thirst-quenching, Muscadet Sèvre et Maine is known as “healthy wine” due to its lack of residual sugar (close to zero) and its moderate alcohol content of 12%. It is the perfect refreshing wine with spicy food. Its iodine aroma brought by the ocean breeze is an ideal complement to Japanese cuisine.

HISTORY

The Muscadet region is located close to the Atlantic Ocean near the mouth of the Loire River. This region, also known as Vins de Nantes, enjoys a mild climate thanks to the Gulf Stream which flows along its Atlantic coast. The city of Nantes was the “Capital of the Kingdom of Brittany” when Anne, Duchess of Bretagne, decided to build the “Château de Nantes.”
