The demand is high, the production is small. Pouilly-Fumé, therefore, is not the most affordable Loire Valley wine. But it is worth the price; considering its style, the quality-price ratio cannot be argued with.

HISTORY

While traveling from Pouilly-Fumé, through Sancerre to the Touraine region, try to save enough time to visit “Château de la Verrerie.” This château was given by King Louis XIV, in 1673, to the Duchess of Portsmouth, a favorite of Charles II of England.
