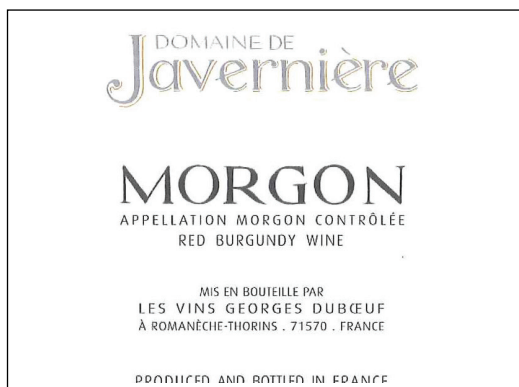

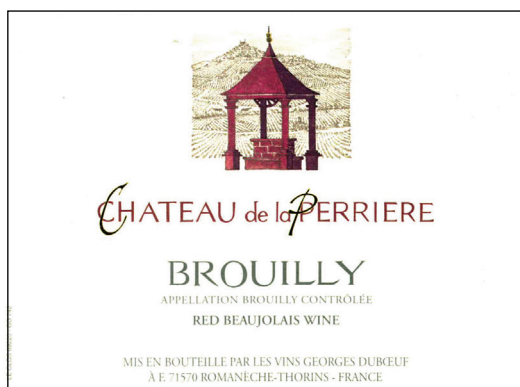

Said to reflect an especially high percentage of old vines – features tart red raspberry and red currant, a sage-like herbal pungency seemingly pointing to some reduction, but a sense of herbal, black tea, and rose hip infusion ultimately adding interest to a soothingly silken, yet bright, as well as satisfyingly persistent finish.

The 2010 Brouilly Château de la Perrière is scented with ripe cassis and blueberry, which come to the palate in juicy exuberance, tinged with cooling coriander and mint as well as saliva-inducing salinity. This is among the more seamless and elegant of Dubœuf's offerings from the vintage and offers excellent value.
