**Georges Dubœuf 2010 Chiroubles  
Flower Label**

Coriander-dusted red currant and red raspberry on the nose carry over onto a bright, juicy, positively tart, buoyant palate. There is a savory underlying sense of meaty pan-drippings that, combined with vivacity of fruit, make for mouthwateringly good value.



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**Georges Dubœuf 2010 Morgon  
Domaine de la Chaponne**

While a touch of roughness and greenness detracted slightly from the berries, the 2010 Morgon Domaine de la Chaponne – grown just outside the hamlet of Morgon itself – mingles ripe dark cherry and peony in the nose, and displays a supple, juicy palate tinged in its finish with coriander and cherry pit.

Domaine de Mont Chavy**

The 2010 Morgon Domaine Mont Chavy is not quite on a level with last year's effort from this long-time Dubœuf collaborator, but it might well be worth following for several years. Scents of cassis and elderflower introduce a generously fruity wine that is at the same time medicinally, herbally bitter and slightly astringent on the palate.

Jean-Ernest Descombes**

Dubœuf's perennially prominently fruity 2010 Morgon J. E. Descombes offers an exuberant abundance of dark cherry and boysenberry garlanded in wisteria, with welcome measures of refreshing primary juiciness and saliva-liberating salinity. At the same time, there is a sense of fine underlying tannin and a bit of extraneous bitterness in the finish.
