2009 Fleurie
Château du Grand Pre

"After a 2008 rendition that outclassed its fellow Fleurie in the Duboeuf portfolio, the 2009 Fleurie Chateau de Grand Pre – tasted from tank – follows in the same impressive mold and then some. Vinification under the direction of owner Claude Zordan involves partial de-stemming and extended, cool fermentation; and the wine will enjoy a longer stay in tank than most of its fellow Duboeuf 2009s. Scents of blueberry, blackberry, and almond extract usher in a juicy and refreshing palate and the finishing buoyancy belies the wine's nearly 14% alcohol. Fruit pit bitterness, tart berry skin, and an illusive but distinctive sense of mineral savor (there is a hint of iodine, but that's not all) render this as intriguing as it is sensually satisfying. I suspect one could enjoyably follow this for at least 3-4 years."
