## BACKGROUND AND CHARACTER

The vineyards of Chateau de Javernand are un-fragmented, covering 66 acres of a 163 acre property in the heart of the Chiroubles appellation. Comfortably situated in the Feuri Park, the bourgeois Chateau Javernand has watched over this estate, owned by the Fourneau family since 1917.

At Chateau de Javernand, each generation has preserved the rich traditions of the estate, such as manual harvesting of entire clusters and traditional winemaking, while introducing the best modern practices of their time. Some of the newer features of the winery are a pneumatic press, controlled temperatures, etc. The fermentation and winemaking facilities were completely renovated in 2001 in order to ensure better quality control.

Today, Peter Fourneau manages the estate, with help from his son Harold. This is the fifth generation of the Fourneau family to tend this property with the care and attention to detail that produces quality wine.
