BACKGROUND AND CHARACTER

The Saint Martin family is a very old family which traces its roots back many generations in the town of Davayé. This beautiful vineyard and property were established by Paul Saint Martin. When Paul passed away in 2003, his wife Gisele took over the operations of the vineyard and estate. Today, with the help of two sharecroppers, she produces remarkable wines.

The age of the vines contributes to the low yield of fruit, concentrating the flavor, and allowing for the creation of an extraordinary wine. For the past 30 years, Georges Duboeuf has purchased the majority of the fruit.

TASTING NOTES

This wine has a beautiful pale golden color. The nose offers aromas of very subtle citrus flavors with hints of honey and lime. A light mineral note reminds one of the proximity to the celebrated Pouilly-Fuissé appellation. This wine is fresh and long on the palate.

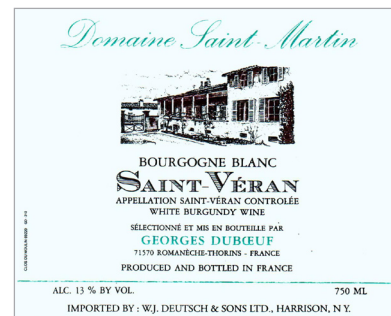
